Sentencing Order under Tennessee Community Corrections Act
Tennessee Code Annotated 40-36-106 (f)
"Supervision as Condition of Probation"

Nothing in this subsection shall prevent a Court from permitting an eligible defendant to participate in a community-based alternative to incarceration as a condition of probation in conjunction with a suspended sentence, split confinement, or periodic confinement as provided in Chapter 35 of this title.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED AND ADJUDGED that said Defendant is to hereby serve this sentence in the community based alternative of the Community Corrections Program for a period of _____ year(s), such being subject to the provisions of the laws of the State of Tennessee.

WEEKEND TIME, as a condition of the Community Corrections sentence.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Defendant shall comply with the following general and specific conditions of the Community Corrections Program.

THE OFFENDER SHALL:

1. Obey the laws of the State of Tennessee and the United States, or any state in which s/he may be, as well as all city or county ordinances.
2. Report all arrests, citations or tickets, regardless of disposition, to the Case Officer.
3. Not receive, own, possess, ship or in any way transport any firearms or ammunition.
4. Procure the consent of his/her Case Officer before changing residence or employment.
5. Make a full and truthful report to his/her Case Officer in person and/or writing as directed and carry out all instructions given by the Case Officer, whether oral or written.
6. Not use intoxicants of any kind, or use intoxicating drugs or alcohol, or abuse prescription medications, or frequent places where intoxicants are sold, dispensed or used.
7. Allow the Case Officer to visit his/her home, employment site or elsewhere, at times to be arranged by the Case Officer.

8. If the Case Officer is not accessible, always direct communication to a Supervisor.
9. Work at a lawful occupation with verifiable wages and support self and/or family to the best of his/her ability.
10. Pay a Fine of \$_____ and Court Costs at the rate of \$_____ per month.
11. Pay **RESTITUTION** as follows:

12. Perform _____ hours of Community Service Work at a nonprofit organization.
13. Submit to random drug/alcohol screens as required.
14. Attend alcohol, drug or psychological evaluation and/or treatment as required.
15. Not leave Tennessee for any reason, for any length of time, unless granted permission by the Court.
16. Allow any law enforcement officer to conduct a search of person, property or dwelling without the necessity of a search warrant.
17. Pay a \$15.00 per month Supervision Fee and a \$30.00 per month CCF fee.
18. Observe all instructions given by the Community Corrections Program.
19. Display appropriate dress and behavior while in the Community Corrections office or while engaging in a Community Corrections activity.
20. Provide a biological specimen for DNA analysis submitted to TBI pursuant to TCA 40-35-321 at the one time cost of \$37.
21. If Court ordered, submit to electronic monitoring at my expense.
22. Observe special conditions imposed by the Court listed below:
